

APPLICATION FOR RESIDENCY IN CLERAUN UNIVERSITY CENTRE

Cleraun is a male-only residence, and we admit students between the ages of 18 and 30 years. We offer students a 'home away from home' where a spirit of family is fostered. We organise various activities throughout the year designed to complement a student's studies, help them to develop universal skills, an interdisciplinary outlook and to see future professional life as a way to serve society.

Students who are thinking about the possibility of applying to stay in Cleraun are welcome to visit and see around the centre by arrangement (with family members, if they wish).

Applications are now being accepted for periods **from 1 September 2023 to 31 May 2024**. Applicants are only offered a place following interview. Places are offered on a term basis, at a minimum.

Fees

Fees for students during the college academic year are €250 per week, payable in instalments per term. (The professional and summer-season rate is €350 per week.) The fee includes meals (breakfast, dinner, and supper, including full meals on weekends), your room, cleaning, bed linen, towels, personal laundry, house utilities, Wi-Fi, and full use of the study facilities.

A deposit of €300 is payable on acceptance of a place which is refunded at the end of the person's stay.
